

CITY OF SALMON ARM STRATEGIC PLAN UPDATE

The City's Strategic Plan Sets Direction for Focused Energy and Financial Certainty

In November 2013, City Council adopted the City's Strategic Plan. The Plan was prepared collaboratively with Council, staff community organizations and residents to reflect the needs and aspirations of the community. The Plan set out the Vision, Values and Five Strategic Drivers which inform key projects to be undertaken in the next 10 years.

So far, the plan has been highly successful in setting direction for the completion of all the short term projects identified in the Plan. These are identified as **Supplementary Core Services Projects**.

In addition, the City has also been able to figure out a way to implement some other key projects that are directly within the mandate of the City and are necessary as part of the City's Core Services. These are known as **Core Services Projects**.

The City will also be able to help move a few projects forward that are really important to the community, but are outside the direct responsibility of the City. These are known as **Community-Based Projects**.

In addition to identifying actions to be taken on all these projects, the City has also set out a financial plan that identifies how all of these projects can be implemented. This results in:

- Potential for 0% property tax increase to deliver on all the projects listed below. (Note: operational costs will be considered on an annual basis); and
- Decrease in the City's allowable debt ratio (from 43% to 42% in 2020).
