It is her understanding that the DAC lease expires on June 30 2018 and at that time the School District will likely decide to dispose of the building 'as is'.

The Commission briefly discussed the state of repair of the old Municipal Hall on Hudson Avenue NE. It was noted that the City currently maintains the building as issues arise.
