The Commission discussed the possibility of including a tree planting in conjunction with its proposed Historical Preservation Award program.

5.3 Preservation of Historical Vistas

THAT: the CHC investigate the feasibility of preserving the Salmon Arm vista from the Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 at 'Tank Hill'.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

The Commission discussed the possibility of trying to preserve the view of Salmon Arm as seen when travelling westward on the Trans-Canada Highway No. 1 at 'Tank Hill'. Members agreed that the view from this location provides a unique perspective of the community, the lake and surrounding hillsides and it would be to the community's benefit if this view could be protected from the construction of tall buildings and highway signs.
