DISTRICT OF SALMON ARM

BYLAW NO. 2940

A bylaw to provide for the delegation of powers, duties and functions

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 176 of the *Municipal Act* [R.S.B.C., 1996, c. 323], the *Council* may provide for the delegation of its powers, duties and functions, including those specifically established by an enactment, to its officers and employees, its committees or its members, or to other bodies established by the local government

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to enact the provisions of Section 176 of the *Municipal Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the *Council* of the *District* of Salmon Arm, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

In this bylaw

Act means the Municipal *Act*;

District means the District of Salmon Arm, a municipality incorporated under the Municipal Act; and

Council means the elected Council of the District.

2. Delegation of Purchasing Power

Council hereby delegates to the Chief Administrative Officer all of the powers, duties and functions of *Council* under Section 176 [1] [a] and Section 176 [1] [b] of the *Act* to make agreements respecting the *District*'s *act*ivities, works or services, but subject to the limitations on that delegated authority as set out in the *District*'s purchasing policy approved by *Council* by resolution on February 23, 1999, as amended from time to time.

3. Scope of Bylaw

For clarity, subject to the Act, unless a power, duty or function of Council has been

expressly delegated by this Bylaw or another *District* Bylaw, all of the powers, duties and functions of *Council* remain with *Council*.

4. Delegation to Persons Holding Position

Where this Bylaw delegates a power, duty or function to a named position, the delegation of the power, duty or function is to the person who from time to time holds the position and to any person who, from time to time, is the deputy of that person so appointed by *Council*.

5. No Delegation by a Delegate

For clarity, a person to whom a power, duty or function has been delegated under this Bylaw has no authority to further delegate to another person any power, duty or function that has been delegated by this Bylaw.

6. Citation

This bylaw may be cited as "District of Salmon Arm Delegation Bylaw No. 2940".
